
The 3 boxes below are the focused activities for nursery pupils this week. Please take some pictures so that you can share what you have been doing with us!

### Hickory, Dickory Dog

- Read/listen to Hickory Dickory Dog.
   There's a separate video of Mrs
   Goodfield reading the story if you don't have a copy of the book at home.
- Why is the dog following the boy to school? Can you remember what the dog does at school? Would you like to take a pet to school? What do you think they would do in school?



#### Sound of the week - b

- Practise forming the letter 'b'.
  Remember the rhyme "Down the laces to the heel and around the toe."
- Watch the 'b' formation video to remind you how to write the sound. (saved separately)
- Watch Mrs Kumar's sound of the week video (saved separately). Can you remember the sounds that we have been learning in school? Remember to practice this a few times this week.
- Choose 2 or 3 sounds that we have looked at so far (m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c and b).
   Ask a grown up to find some items beginning with those sounds. See if you can match the items to their starting sound. You could try this with lots of our sounds.



## **Mathematics**

- Watch Mrs Goodfield's number of the week video.
- Focus on forming the number '2' carefully. Use our rhyme to help you "Half a heart will never do, slide to the right and make a 2."



Half a heart will never do, Slide to the right, make a 2.

- Extension If you are really good at recognising the number 2, counting out 2 objects and writing number 2, you could really challenge yourself by writing '12' and counting out 12 objects.
- Have a look around your house and see if you can find two of lots of items. It could be 2 apples, 2 cups, 2 cars. Can you make a collection? Check you have 2 of each item that you have collected.







• Go on a number 2 hunt with your family. You might spot the number on cars, bins or signs. House numbers are good to look at too.

#### Cymraeg

- Have a look at the Welsh weather video saved separately. We've added some extra phrases for you to learn this week.
- Have a go at playing the 'splat' game that you saw on the video with your family.
   How many different types of weather can you remember? There is a set of cards saved separately for you to use if you like.
