Online Safety for Parents is an informative and supportive session designed to help parents and carers understand the risks young people face online, and how to guide them in using technology safely and responsibly. Today's young people are born into a world where advanced technology exists and for this 'Cyber Savvy' generation, the right and ability to use technology manifests itself in a myriad of ways with young people learning, communicating, socialising and gaming through, with and because of technology.

Technology is easily abused and misused and if we are allowing our children use of and access to these tools, we must ensure they are able to use them safely and respectfully

This 2-hour workshop provides practical advice, up-to-date information, and simple strategies for protecting children in an ever-changing digital world.

This workshop helps parents to:

- Understand popular apps, games, and social media platforms
- Recognise online risks such as online bullying, grooming, and inappropriate content
- Learn how to set boundaries and use parental controls effectively
- Start open, honest conversations about online behaviour and safety

We are delighted to invite all parents to an Online Safety Workshop led by an external presenter on Tuesday, 3rd March at 3.40pm.

As you know, online safety is an extremely important topic, and together we can help support our children in navigating the digital world safely.

The workshop will cover key aspects of keeping children safe online and provide practical advice for parents. It will last approximately 1 hour and will begin at 3:40 pm, once all children have been dismissed.

Inclement weather school closure

With the unpredictable weather conditions that we often experience, it is necessary for us to have a plan in place for any potential school closures. If the school has to close due to adverse weather conditions, we will contact you via text message and email at the earliest opportunity.

Therefore, it is crucial that you ensure all your contact details are up to date and that you are receiving school communications regularly.

In the event of a school closure, our dedicated teaching staff will set work for the children using various online platforms. For Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3, the work will be set on Seesaw. Years 4, 5, and 6 will have their work set on Google Classroom via Hwb. These platforms have been chosen to ensure a seamless continuation of your child's education from the comfort of your home.

To ensure a smooth transition to online learning, please make sure that you have your child's login details readily available. Our staff will be unable to provide these details if the school has to close at short notice.

We sincerely hope that adverse weather conditions do not disrupt our school operations. However, it is always better to be prepared. We will continue to monitor the weather closely and if any closures are necessary, we will inform you promptly.
